

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Hall on Wednesday April 27, 1938 at 2:00 P.M.

Seth A. Hubbard, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting held on April 13, 1938 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Mr. Harry Saxstien, Attorney addressing the Board in regard to the sidewalk project at Aquebogue, stating that it is a very aggravating situation and inquired whether or not they will get any action on the matter.

Mr. Saxstien also spoke in regard to the reorganization of the Justices Court and recommended that a general clerk and stenographer be appointed to keep the records of the Justices and also take down the proceedings of the Justices Court, which would keep the records in one office. He further stated that this was not only his recommendation but the recommendation of thirty or more attorneys in Town.

Mr. Donald Eastman addressed the Board and requested the Board to fill in the gully between his property and the Howell M. Reeve Park. He stated that it would improve both properties and make more parking space, which is greatly needed. He also stated that he was willing to allow the Town to drag dirt from his property to help fill it in. The matter was referred to the Park Committee and the Highway Committee.

Justice Kelly brought the matter of purchasing a break testing machine for the Police Dept. to the attention of the Board, stating that it is greatly needed and recommended that the Police Dept. be authorized to purchase same.

On motion made by Justice Kelly and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that the Police Dept. be authorized to purchase a break testing machine for the sum not to exceed \$40.00. The Vote, Justices Zaleski, Kelly, Warner and Boutcher, Yes, Supervisor Homan, Yes. Total Vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Justice Zaleski offered the following resolution, which was seconded by Justice Boutcher,

WHEREAS the members of this Board have learned with deepest regret of the death of Miss Anna Konchalski, Secretary to the Supervisor, and

WHEREAS the members of this Board sincerely believe that the

Town of Riverhead has lost a true and faithful servant, and

WHEREAS, the members of this Board have appreciated her efforts and enjoyed her friendship, now therefore be it,

RESOLVED, that this Board extend to Mrs. Ann Konchalski and family their expression of deepest sympathy, and further

RESOLVED that this Resolution be spread in full on the minutes and a copy be sent to the family. The Resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the bills for the month of April 1938.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, May 11, 1938 at 2:00 P.M.
