

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, September 14, 1938 at 2:00 P.M.

Seth A. Hubbard, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on August 31, 1938 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from Mr. S. Alper of Riverhead, N.Y. in regard to the over flow of water on his property at the corner of Osborn Ave. and Railroad St. during every heavy rain, which costs him much business each time. The matter was referred to the Supt. of Highways.

A petition signed by several taxpayers on East Main St. requesting the Board to include an appropriation in the 1939 budget for the purpose of building curbs and gutters on the south side of East Main St., beginning at the property of the Standard Oil Company and extending east to the Long Island Rail Road. The matter was referred to the Supt. of Highways and the petition was ordered placed on file.

Supervisor Homan submitted his report for the month of August 1938 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Mr. Frank J. Beagan representative of P.W.A. addressed the Board in regard to P.W.A. projects, stating the method in which to make applications, also the time limit in which applications will be received.

The Board discussed various sidewalk projects and also the feasibility of building a Town Highway barn under P.W.A. The matter was deferred for future consideration.

The Supt. of Highways brought the matter of the bill from the Travelers Insurance Company for additional premium on the Highway Department's 1937 payroll. The matter was referred to the Town Attorney.

There being no further business, on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, September 21, 1938 at 2:00 P.M.
