

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, September 28, 1938 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of meetings held on September 14, 1938 and September 21, 1938 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from John G. Peck, County Treasurer requesting the Board to furnish satisfaction of the Tax Receiver's bonds of Riverhead Town, if there is no objection thereto. The communication was ordered placed on file.


On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Kelly, it was Resolved that there is no objection on the part of the Town of Riverhead to the satisfaction of the Tax Receiver's Bond for 1937-1938 provided the audit by the County Treasurer shows no objection thereto. The Resolution was carried by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A communication was read from the Riverhead Branch of the Northfork Chapter of the American Red Cross expressing its appreciation for placing a Life Guard at the Pier Avenue Beach, during the swimming campaign. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A petition signed by over 50 taxpayers and residents of the Town of Riverhead, requesting the Town Board to appropriate the sum of \$500.00 in the budget for 1939 for the purpose of band concerts during the summer months of 1939. The petition was ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the bills for the month of September, 1938.

There being no further business, on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Tuesday October 4, 1938 at 11:00 A.M.
