

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, January 27, 1937 at 9:00 A. M.

Roger M. Wiley, Town Attorney, and William H. Clark, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on January 13, 1937 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from the Association of Towns of the State of New York giving Notice that the 5th Annual Meeting of the Association will be held in the City of Albany, New York on Wednesday, February 24th and Thursday, February 25th, 1937.

Supervisor Burns informed the Board that he intended to attend the Annual meeting of the said Association to be held in Albany on the said dates.

On motion made by Justice Kelly and seconded by Justice Warner, it was RESOLVED that Supervisor Milton L. Burns, be designated to represent the Town of Riverhead at the 5th Annual Meeting of the Association of Towns of the State of New York at Albany on February 24th and 25th, 1937. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Mr. Robert R. Brown of Greenport, New York addressed the Board and made application for a franchise to operate a bus line on and along the Main Road (known as Route 25) from the Southold Town line to Riverhead. He was advised by the Board to submit a written application at the next meeting at which time the matter will be taken up.

An offer was made by Mr. Lynn B. Young to sell to the Town of Riverhead a tract of land consisting of approximately 18 acres adjoining the Town Dump, said land to be used to supply loam and sand. The matter was referred to the Highway Committee, Town Attorney and the Supt. of Highways.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the Town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote, the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, February 10, 1937 at 9:00 A. M.
