

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, October 27, 1937 at 9:00 A. M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on October 13, 1937 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication from the United States War Department in regard to the application of Mr. J. Frederick Pye, for a War Department permit to construct a bulkhead and two jetties in Great Peconic Bay, South Jamesport was read and ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from the Honorable Robert L. Bacon acknowledging receipt of a map of Peconic River showing the work done by the Township and County. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from H.F. Bishop, County Superintendent of Highways inclosing a certificate and notice to close a portion of the Old Country Road to traffic during construction work. The communication and certificate was ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from Mr. George W. Hildreth, President of the Board of Education requesting the Town Board to make several improvements about the property of the new high school on Pulaski Street. The communication was referred to the Highway Committee and the Supt. of Hghwys.

A communication was read from Mr. Lee Hollingsworth in regard to straightening Pulaski Street in the vicinity of Raynor Avenue. The matter was referred to the Highway Committee.

A communication was read from the Long Island Lighting Company together with a schedule showing the time street lights are turned on and off. The communication and schedule was ordered placed on file.

The Supervisor's report for the month of September, 1937 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the bills for the month of October, 1937.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet in the Town Hall on Thursday, October 28, 1937 at 7:30 P.M.
