

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, November 10, 1937 at 9:00 A. M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on October 27th, minutes of a Budget Hearing held on October 28th, and minutes of a special meeting held on November 5, 1937 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes addressed the Board in regard to fixing the amount of his Bond and also relative to appointing clerks for his Department stating that he will need at least four, due to the two payment plan.


On motion made by Justice Luce and seconded by Justice Boutcher, it was RESOLVED that the Bond of Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes be fixed at \$50,000.00. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Kelly and Luce, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes, 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Kelly, it was RESOLVED that the Receiver of Taxes be and he hereby is authorized to hire not more than four clerks at the rate of \$4.00 per day. The vote, Justice Warner, Boutcher, Kelly and Luce, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Superintendent of Highways Clark submitted a map showing a proposed change in Pulaski Street adjoining land of R. Lee Hollingsworth and Mrs. Wm. H. Leonard. The map was ordered placed on file for future consideration.

The Supervisor's report for the month of October, 1937 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was ordered placed on file.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, November 24, 1937 at 9:00 A. M.
