On motion duly made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Luce it was RESOLVED, that in compliance with an order of the HONORABLE MITCHELL MAY, Justice of the Supreme Court, dated March 10th, 1936, RALPH W. GALLAGHER be and he hereby is restored to the position of night clerk in the police headquarters of the Town of Riverhead from the 1st day of January, 1936 to the 17th day of February, 1936, the date of the abolition of said position, and it is further

RESOLVED that the supervisor be instructed to pay to said RALPH W. GALLAGHER his salary for such period being One hundred and fifty (\$150.00) Dollars, together with Fifty (\$50.00) costs and Nineteen & 47/100 (\$19.47) Dollars disbursements, total Two hundred nineteen & 47/100 (\$219.47) Dollars. The vote, Justices Warner, Kelly and Luce, Yes, Justice Butcher, Absent, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Absent 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.
