The following bids for police uniforms were opened and presented to the Board: Anton F. Vojvoda & Son, \$42.00, George B. Griffing \$35.50, and Perkins & Co. \$35.00.

On motion duly made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Kelly it was RESOLVED that Perkins & Co. be awarded the contract to supply Police uniforms (4 piece all wool 14 oz. blue serge indigo) for the sum not to exceed \$35.00 per uniform. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Kelly and Luce, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A communication was read from Bennie S. Czeripinski of Jamesport, N. Y. in regard to no parking signs in front of the Jamesport Post Office. The matter was referred to the Police Committee.


Justice Kelly offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Boutcher

WHEREAS, a survey was made of the present automobile insurance, based on the present status of the Town of Riverhead highway equipment and

WHEREAS it was shown by said survey that a blanket coverage of all automobile equipment owned by the Town of Riverhead would save considerable premium and in addition offer fleet service, now therefore be it

RESOLVED that the Traverlers Insurance Company of Hartford Connecticut be and it hereby is authorized to put all automobiles and motorcycles owned by the Town of Riverhead under one policy, providing that it would automatically insure all automobiles and trailers owned by the assured at any time during the policy year. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Kelly and Luce, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to April 29, 1936 at 9:00 A.M.
