

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of River-
held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, May 27, 1936 at 9:00 A.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on May 13, 1936
read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Proof of publication of the notice of enactment of the Town
Ordinance from the Riverhead News was submitted to the Board and on
motion and vote was ordered placed on file.

Affidavit of posting said notice in three places within the
Town was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was ordered placed on
file.

Mr. William Miller of Wading River addressed the Board in
regard to the appointment of a Special Policeman to serve at the Wading River
parking area adjacent to the beach.

On motion duly made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice
Boutcher, it was RESOLVED that Peter Lusik of Wading River be and he hereby
appointed Special Policeman of the Town of Riverhead to serve at Wading
River, when and as directed by the Special Policeman in Charge during the
period beginning May 30th, 1936 and ending September 7th, 1936, at the rate
of \$3.60 per day for each day of service during such period. This appoint-
ment is further subject to revocation by the Town Board at any time during
such period. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Kelly and Luce, Yes, Super-
visor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon de-
clared duly adopted.

The matter of a zoning ordinance was discussed. The Super-
visor appointed the Town Board as a Committee of the whole to study the matter
at the next Town Board meeting.

A communication was read from Mr. A.W. Conklin in regard to a
settlement for a permanent easement through the property of his wife Mrs. Jennie
Conklin near Sweezy Avenue.

The matter was referred to the Highway Committee.

Assessor Charles O. Morse addressed the Board in regard to
the mileage rate for the Board of Assessors. The matter was referred to a
Committee composed of Justice Luce and Justice Warner.

Mrs. Percy V. Ketcham addressed the Board in regard to life guards and safety equipment for the public beaches of the Town.

The matter was ordered placed on the calendar for the next Board meeting.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the Town bills for the month of May, 1936.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, June 10, 1936 at 9:00 A.M.
