

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of River-  
head, held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, June 10, 1936 at 9:00 A.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held May 27, 1936 were  
read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from W.P.A. in regard to sponsoring  
a project for the development of an airport in this vicinity. The communication  
was ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from Mr. Clyde Tooker in regard to  
a drain on Riverside Drive which carries off surface water. The matter was  
referred to the Highway Committee.

Mr. Edwin C. Duryea of South Jamesport addressed the Board  
in regard to opening East Willow Street and Third Street in that Village.

Roger M. Wiley, Town Attorney, advised the Board that no  
action be taken on the above matter until such time when the property is  
properly dedicated to the Town in accordance with the Highway Law.

On motion duly made by Justice Kelly and seconded by Justice  
Boutcher it was RESOLVED that Raymond G. Benjamin of Riverhead, N. Y. be and he  
hereby is appointed Life Guard at the Beach at Howell M. Reeve Park and it is  
so ordered.

RESOLVED that the said Life Guard serve at the pleasure of  
the Board beginning on the 27th day of June, 1936 and not later than the 8th  
day of September, 1936, salary at the rate of \$20.00 per week for seven days  
each week from 10:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. The vote, Justice Warner, Absent, Justices  
Boutcher, Kelly and Luce, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Ab-  
sent 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.


The Supervisors report for the month of May, 1936 was sub-
