

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of
Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Friday, February 1, 1935 at 9:00 A. M.


George E. Luce,

Justice Hallock offered the following resolution which was
seconded by Justice Luce.

WHEREAS: the Town Board has determined that the amount levied
and collected for the expenditure actually necessary for the removal of
obstructions caused by snow are insufficient to pay expenses necessarily
incurred, now therefore be it,

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be and he is hereby authorized
and directed to borrow the sum of Fifty Eight Hundred (\$5800.00) Dollars
to be used for the removal of snow. The vote, Justices Luce and Hallock,
Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 3, No 0. The resolution was
thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion of Justice Luce and seconded by Justice Hallock,
the meeting adjourned till Wednesday, February 13, 1935 at 10:00 A. M.
