

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, July 10, 1935 at 9:00 A. M.

Town Attorney Smith was present.

On motion made, seconded and carried Justice Rubenstein was duly elected chairman of the meeting.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on June 26, 1935 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Stackpole and seconded by Justice Hallock it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized to transfer the sum of \$300.00 from the Surplus Account to a new account to be known as the Howell M. Reeve Park Account for the purpose of paying the salary of the Life Guard at Reeve Park and for necessary equipment. The vote, Supervisor Burns, absent, Justices Stackpole, Luce, Hallock and Rubenstein, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, No 0, Absent 1, The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A communication was read from S. Wentworth Horton, Supervisor of the Town of Southold requesting the Town Board of Riverhead to pass a resolution approving and endorsing the project of improving Sterling Basin, Greenport Harbor, and on motion and vote it was RESOLVED that the letter be acknowledged, and the matter laid on the table due to the projects pending in the Town of Riverhead.

The matter of accepting Prospect Place as a Town Highway was discussed by the Board.

A Committee composed of Justices Hallock and Luce together with Supt. of Highways Clark was appointed to investigate the matter and report.

On motion and vote the Supervisor's report for the month of June, 1935 was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Town Board convened as a Board of Audit and examined the Town Welfare bills for the month of June 1935.

On motion made by Justice Stackpole and seconded by Justice Luce it was RESOLVED by unanimous consent that the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized to pay the Welfare bills for the month of June as approved by the Welfare Officer of the Town.

Justice Stackpole offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Hallock

WHEREAS the bills of the Welfare Department for the month of June, 1935 show approximately 100% increase over the bills for the month of June, 1934, now be it

RESOLVED that the Supervisor be authorized forthwith to request the T.E.R.A. to immediately assign a Case Supervisor for the Town of Riverhead. The vote, Supervisor Burns, absent, Justices Stackpole, Luce Hallock and Rubenstein, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, absent 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board recessed at 12:15 noon to reconvene at 1:30 P. M.


The Town Board reconvened at 1:30 P. M.
