

Minutes of a Special Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Hall on Friday, February 16, 1934 at 10:00 A. M., pursuant to a notice.

Town Attorney Reginald C. Smith was present.


On motion duly made by Justice Stackpole and seconded by Justice Rubenstein, it was Resolved: That the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, to support the application of the Sound Shore Road as a C. W. A. Project, appropriate the use of the necessary trucks, graders, and other equipment required for the project, and be it further Resolved: That the sum of \$1200 be and the same is hereby appropriated from the Town Highway Funds, for the purpose of materials. The vote, Justices, Burnside, Stackpole, Luce and Rubenstein, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total votes, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly carried.

On motion duly made by Justice Stackpole and seconded by Justice Rubenstein, it was Resolved: That the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead appropriate the use of all necessary tools for the completion of the Sound Shore Road as a C. W. A. Project from tools now in stock, which are the property of the Town of Riverhead, in the custody of the Highway Department of the Town of Riverhead. The vote, Justices Burnside, Stackpole, Luce and Rubenstein, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total votes, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly carried.

The matter of building a road in back of the Riverhead Cemetery, extending from Roanoke Avenue westerly, in order that the people living in back of the Cemetery may have a public outlet to Roanoke Avenue, and that property taken up by the road is to be donated to the Town, was brought to the attention of the Town Board.

Supervisor Burns referred the above to Justice Burnside and Justice Luce as Committee to confer with the Superintendent of Highways and the Town Attorney.

There being no further business on motion and vote, the meeting adjourned at 11:30.
