

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead  
held on October 4, 1934 at 10 A.M. pursuant to a Resolution.

Mr George W. Hildreth addressed the Board and presented a petition signed by a number of taxpayers of the Town of Riverhead requesting that the sum of \$750.00 be raised by taxation for the year 1935 for the installation and maintenance of markers in the Peconic River and Peconic Bay within the Town of Riverhead. The petition by unanimous consent was ordered placed on file.

On motion duly made by Justice Luce and seconded by Justice Burnside, it was RESOLVED that the Clerk give notice of the adoption and filing of the foregoing annual estimate which shall set forth said estimate in full and that a hearing will be held for the review thereof at a meeting of the Town Board at the Town Hall on the 23rd day of October 1934 at 7:30 P.M. and further

RESOLVED that the Clerk publish such notice in the Riverhead News at Riverhead, N.Y. pursuant to Law. The vote, Justices Burnside, Stackpole and Luce, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Town Welfare Officer M.M. Burr presented a deed from Joseph Smith, Jamesport, N.Y. conveying a piece of property to the Town Of Riverhead.

On motion duly made by Justice Stackpole and seconded by Justice Luce it was RESOLVED that the aforesaid deed from Joseph Smith to the Town of Riverhead be and the same hereby is accepted. The resolution was carried by the unanimous consent of the Board.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned till Tuesday October 16, 1934 at 10 A.M.
