

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held on October 16, 1934 at 10 A.M.

Town Attorney Reginald C. Smith and Supt. of Highways William Clark were present.

The minutes of the Town Board meeting held on October 4, 1934 were read and on motion and vote duly adopted.

A communication from the Lakeside Engineering Corporation, information in regard to the construction of a Sewage Treating Plant was presented to the Board. The Clerk was directed to acknowledge the letter and inform them to refer the matter to Fred J. Biele, Sanitary Engineer, Huntington N.Y.

A communication from J. Harry Saxstien, Attorney in regard to the matter of Mrs Max E. Adams and the Welfare Department was presented to the Board.

The Clerk was directed to acknowledge the letter and inform Mr Saxstien to refer the matter to the Patchogue Office of the TERA.

Proof of publication from the Riverhead News of the notice of reconveying property to the original ^{owner} on the proposed Saw Mill Brook Road which had been abandoned. Proof of Publication of notice of the hearing on the proposed Sewer District from the County Review and the Town Clerk's affidavit of posting the notice of reconveying the aforesaid property to the original owners in five public places within the Town were presented to the Board and on motion and vote were ordered placed on file.

Supt. of Highways Clark addressed the Board stating that he has a 1928 International one yard dump truck that he wishes to trade for a later model three yard dump truck which has been only 25,000 miles and which would be just as good to him as a new truck with a saving to the Town of approximately \$900.00.

On motion duly made by Justice Luce and seconded by Justice Stackpole it was RESOLVED, that Superintendent of Highways Clark be and he hereby is authorized to purchase a three yard dump truck for a sum not to exceed \$575.00 and as part payment thereon the seller to transfer the one yard International dump truck. The Vote, Justices Stackpole and Luce, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total Vote Yes 3, No 0. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Supervisors Report for the month of September 1934 was presented to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Roselle G. Benjamin, Manager Of the Riverhead Water District presented an estimate of cost for the erection of a building 20'X 30' at the Water Plant to be used as a garage and storage room.

On motion duly made by Justice Stackpole and seconded by Justice Luce it was RESOLVED, that Roselle G. Benjamin manager of the Riverhead Water District be and he hereby is authorized to construct a garage and storage building 20'X30', not to exceed the sum of \$500.00. The Vote Justices Stackpole and Luce, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes, Total Vote, Yes 3, No 0. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

J. A. Pritchard, Stenographer, Patchogue, N.Y. presented the minutes of the hearing in the matter of a petition for the establishment of a Sanitary Sewer District in the Town of Riverhead held on October 2nd, 1934 and on motion and vote the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion duly made by Justice Stackpole and seconded by Justice Luce it was RESOLVED, that the store vacant in the Ivans Block on Railroad Avenue, Riverhead N.Y. be rented for the use as a sewing room for the sum not to exceed \$10.00 per month. The Town to furnish their own heat and light. The Vote, Justices Stackpole and Luce, Yes Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total Vote, Yes 3, No 0. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion duly made by Justice Luce and seconded by Justice Stackpole it was RESOLVED, that the Town sell to ~~Joan~~ Frank Gatz of Jamesport, New York, property belonging to the Town formerly owned by Joseph Smith bounded on the north by land of ~~Joan~~ Frank Gatz, on the East by Herrick Road, on the South by a roadway and on the West by George Fisher, containing 1/3 acre, for the sum of One Hundred & 00/100 (\$100..) Dollars, and that the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to execute and deliver to the said ~~Joan~~ Frank Gatz a quit-claim deed for said premises, and it is further,

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk publish the notice of this Resolution pursuant to Section 90 of the Town Law in the County Review at Riverhead, New York. The Vote, Justices Stackpole and Luce, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total Vote Yes 3, No 0. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned till Thursday, October 18, 1934 at 5:00 P.M.
