Benjamin, manager of the Riverhead Water District be and he hereby is authorized to insure the Ford automobile purchased by the Riverhead Water District for Liability, property damage, collision, Fire and Theft, and further

Resolved that the insurance be placed with C. DeWitt Benjamin. The Vote, Justice Burnside absent, Justice Stackpole absent, Justices Luce and Rubenstein, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

There being no further business on motion duly made by Justice Rubenstein and seconded by Justice Luce it was Resolved by the unanimous consent of the Board to adjourn till Wednesday November 14th, 1934 at 1 P.M.
