

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office on Friday, November 4th 1932 at 2 P.M.

Raymond S. Welch, Town Superintendent of Highways was present.

A Petition, signed by residents of West Main Street, Riverhead, was presented and read, requesting that a sidewalk be erected on the north side of West Main Street, between the Buick showroom and the Upper Mills Electric Plant. Justice Rubenstein suggested that the residents of this section of the Town form a sidewalk District.

The Board was addressed by Cedric M. Luce, of Sound Avenue, who suggested that the rate of wages as paid by the Highway Department should be the same as that paid by the farmers.

The Board was also addressed by J. Harry Brown, who advised that in his opinion the expenditure of money by the Town for curbs and gutters was a fine investment.

The Board was also addressed by Raymond H. Vail and Daniel R. Young, relative to the matter of highways and the budget.

Justice Rubenstein, reporting for the Highway Committee of the Town Board, made the following recommendations as to the amount of money to be raised for highway purposes for the year 1933.
