

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the  
Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on  
Wednesday, November 23, 1932 at 2 P.M.

The minutes of the Town Board meeting held November  
10, 1932 were read and on motion and vote duly adopted.

A communication was read from Margaret E. Ireland  
of Greenport, N.Y. commending Special Constable Walter  
F. Luce, for the fine manner in which he handled the  
automobile accident on October 24, 1932, in which she was  
injured.

On motion duly made, seconded and unanimously  
carried it was Resolved That this Town Board express  
to Special Constable Walter Luce, its commendation for  
the fine manner in which he handled the automobile  
accident in which Margaret E. Ireland was injured.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was  
Resolved That Attorney Edwim M. Lockwood be and he hereby  
is appointed counsel for the Town of Riverhead to look  
into the matter of the bank tax refund as claimed by the  
Suffolk County National Bank and render an opinion to  
the Town Board.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was  
Resolved That the Supervisor and the Town Clerk be and  
they hereby are authorized and directed to borrow upon  
certificate of indebtedness, the sum of Ten Thousand  
Dollars to pay on account of audited bills of November  
22, 1932

Bond No. 9372-A of the National Surety Company,  
Bonding Supervisor Dennis G. Homan in favor of the Town  
of Riverhead, in the sum of Forty Two Thousand Two  
Hundred Fourteen and 19/100 Dollars, as required by the

State Highway Commission, pursuant to Section No.104 of the Highway Law, for highway money for the year 1932.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That this Board hereby approve the Bond No. 9372-A of the National Surety Company, bonding Dennis G. Homan as Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead, in the sum of \$42,214.19, as to its form, manner of execution and sufficiency of the sureties therein.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the calendar system be made effective for the Town Board of Riverhead, and that all matters to come before the Town Board must be in the hands of the Town Clerk so that he might render the calendar to the members of the Town Board by the Saturday preceeding the Town Board Meeting and that all matters not on the calendar cannot be heard without the unanimously consent of the Town Board.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes, addressed the Board, relative to the matter of having Burglary and Hold-Up insurance written insuring him as Receiver of Taxes while collecting taxes.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the Receiver of Taxes be and he hereby is authorized and directed to have insurance written insuring him as Receiver of Taxes, against Hold Up and Burglary in the amount of \$10,000 each, for a period of three months.

The Highway Committee reporting on the matter of constructing a Town Dock at South Jamesport, N.Y., requested that it be authorized to seek advice of counsel as to the right of the Superintendent of Highways to erect such a dock.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the Highway Committee be and it hereby is authorized to engage counsel for an opinion as to the right of the Superintendent of Highways and the Town of Riverhead, to erect a town dock.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the Town Board meet on December 7th, and December 21st at 2 P.M.

There being no further business, on motion and vote the meeting adjourned.
