

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Wednesday, June 24, 1931 at 12:45 P.M.

On motion and vote, it was decided to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the last meeting of the Town Board.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the Supervisor and the Town Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to borrow upon certificates of indebtedness the sum of \$5500.00 to pay on account of audited bills of June 23, 1931.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That this Board call a public hearing, on the advisability of establishing a Town Planning Board, to be held on July 8, 1931 at 2:15 P.M., and be it further Resolved That notice of said public hearing be given the public by publishing notice of said hearing in the local papers for two weeks.

The Board thereupon conducted an election for the purpose of voting on the establishment of a police district pursuant to a petition of Jacob Zak and others, said election being held between the hours of 1 P. M. and 4 P.M.

There were 324 votes cast at said election of which 197 voted against the establishment of the district, 118 voted in favor of the establishment of the district, and there were 9 void and blank ballots.

The Board, on motion and vote adjourned at 4:20 P.M.
