

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Thursday, December 31, 1931 at 2 P.M.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board held Wednesday, December 23, 1931, were read and on motion and vote adopted.

Supervisor Homan presented bond in the Amount of \$50,000 for the approval of the Board.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That Bond No. 13593 of the Concord Casualty and Surety Company, bonding Dennis G. Homan, as Supervisor in the amount of \$50,000 be and the same hereby is approved.

The Highway committee reporting on the matter of restricting parking to one side of East Avenue, recommended that parking be restricted to the west side of East Avenue from East Main Street to East Second Street.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That parking be allowed on the west side of East Avenue only, from East Main Street to East Second Street and that the Parking Ordinances of the Town be changed accordingly effective as of this date.

It was decided to hold over the protest of Frank Haupt in reference to the opening of a highway at South Jamesport for the attention of the new Town Board.

William H. Barnes, Chairman of the Emergency Relief Committee advised that good progress was being made on the projects on Wading River Road and Doctor's Path.

Supervisor Homan requested that from \$300 to \$500.00 be used under the relief work for making a road into the Town Dump and for improving said dump.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That this Board does hereby approve of the following work to be done under the supervision of the Superintendent of Highways, subject to the approval of the State Emergency Relief Administration.

Project No. 6.

Work on Town Dump, making and improving road into dump, cleaning up Town Dump etc.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried the meeting adjourned to meet on Tuesday, January 5, 1932 at 3 P.M.
