

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Wednesday, January 15, 1930 at 2 P. M.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board held January 3, 1930 were read and on motion and vote adopted.

The Lighting Committee recommended that the petition for two additional street lights at Wading River be granted and that one street light on Roanoke Avenue be moved and two additional street lights added.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the Long Island Lighting Company be notified to install two 80 C.P. street lights in the Wading River District and to move one street light on Roanoke Avenue, and install two additional 80 C.P. Street lights in this section, in the Riverhead Lighting District.

The Registrar of Vital Statistics advised that he had appointed Byron Rogers as Deputy Registrar of Vital Statistics.

Supervisor Homan advised that he had re-appointed Julian Rubenstein as his clerk effective as of January 1, 1930 and requested that the Board fix the compensation of his clerk.

On motion duly made and seconded it was RESOLVED That the compensation of Julian Rubenstein as Clerk of the Supervisor be and the same is hereby fixed at \$1800.00 per year.

Attorney Almon G. Rasquin was present and presented his opinion regarding the administration of the Town Public Welfare matter.

On motion duly made and seconded, it was Resolved That Thomas E. Greene be and he hereby is appointed Town Public Welfare Officer of and for the Town of Riverhead effective as of January 1, 1930 at a yearly compensation of \$500.00

Harold Robinson addressed the Board relative to the road known as Park Road leading to the Town Park Property, advising that he considered that this land used for the highway to be worth more than the \$300.00 which had been offered him.

Supervisor Homan referred this matter to a committee consisting of Justice Fafinski and Justice Miller for investigation.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes requested that he be allowed a clerk to assist him for an additional four weeks.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes be and he hereby is allowed a clerk to assist him for a period of four weeks, the compensation of said clerk to be \$5.00 per day.

There being no further business, on motion and vote, the meeting adjourned to meet on January 29, 1930 at 2 P.M.
