

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Thursday, September 11, 1930 at 2 P.M.

The minutes of the regular Town Board meeting held August 27, 1930 and the minutes of the Special Meeting of the Town Board, held September 3, 1930 were read and on motion and vote adopted.

A communication received from residents of Wading River, commending Office John Burgess, for the manner in which he handled the traffic at Wading River was read and ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from J.H. Hildreth, Supervisor of Marine Fisheries of the State of New York, relative to the conditions of Peconic River caused by the disposal of sewerage in said river.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, is ready to cooperate with the Department of Health of the State of New York, in taking the necessary steps to eliminate the cause of Pollution of Peconic River, and be it further Resolved That copies of the foregoing resolutions be forwarded to the State Department of Health and the Bureau of Marine Fisheries.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That Lorimer M. Raynor, be and he hereby is appointed Attendance Officer of and for the Town of Riverhead for the school year 1930-1931 and that the compensation of said attendance officer be and the same is hereby fixed at \$5.00 per day and \$.15 per mile expenses, for each mile necessarily traveled in the performance of his duties.

Oscar F. Karlein and Moratio Lowe of Calverton, addressed the Board relative to the Forge Dam and Town Highway leading across thereof, advising that Town Superintendent of Highway Murray of Brookhaven Town and inspected said dam and highway with Charles O. Downs, Town Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead and that Mr. Murray would advise what action the Town Board of Brookhaven Town would take in this matter.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, co-operate with the Town Board of the Town of Brookhaven and take the necessary steps to re-construct the Forge Dam, on Peconic River, at Calverton, N.Y.

Mr. Maud, representative of the Davey Tree Expert Company, advised having made an inspection of the trees in the village with Town Superintendent of Highways Charles O. Downs, Mr. Maud was requested to submit an estimate as to the number of trees which should be removed and the cost of removing same and the cost of removing dangerous wood from other trees.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned to meet on September 24th 1930 at 2 P.M.
