

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Monday, October 6, 1930 at 7:30 P.M.

A petition for street lights on River Avenue, within the Riverhead Lighting District was presented and referred to the lighting committee for investigation.

A bill was presented from Florence M. Case, for personal injury and damage to clothing and ordered placed on file.

Horatio Lowe and Oscar F. Karlein were present and advised that representatives of the Brookhaven Town Board had inspected the Forge Dam with County Engineer A.O. Smith and County Engineer Smith advised he would want a record of the accepting of the highway across the Forge Dam before drawing up plans and specifications for a new dam.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, the following resolution was duly adopted:

WHEREAS, There was a highway laid out across the Forge Dam in the year 1869, and

WHEREAS, The record of said highway has been lost or mislaid, Now Therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Town Surveyor make a survey of a road leading from the Old River Road, south across the said Forge Dam to the Town Line, and the Superintendent of Highways be instructed to lay out and open said highway to take the place of said highway existing in 1869.

Justice William L. Miller was appointed a committee of one to present a copy of the foregoing resolution before the Town Board of the Town of Brookhaven.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried the Town Clerk was instructed to have notices running in the local papers changed as follows:

Discontinue notice headed " \$25.00 Reward ", relative to dumping rubbish on the highways.

Change notice headed " Highway Opening, Must get permit and deposit check for at least \$10.00" ^{to read} as follows:

" Highway Notice pursuant to Resolution of the Town Board passed June 27, 1928. Any one disturbing streets or highways in the Town of Riverhead, must obtain written consent from the Superintendent of Highways and deposit at least \$10.00 with Supervisor of said town for each and every opening"

Discontinue Election Notice as appearing and publish dates and hours of registration and the polling places only.

After considerable discussion as to the amount necessary to insert in the budget for the year 1931, the meeting adjourned at 10.15 P.M.
