

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Wednesday, October 15th 1930 at 2 P.M.

Charles O. Downs, Town Superintendent of Highways was present.

The minutes of the Town Board meetings held September 24th, September 26th and October 6th, 1930 were read and on motion and vote adopted.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That Attorney Nathan O. Petty be employed by the Town of Riverhead, to represent said Town in the matter of Hensley vs Hensley.

A bill from Dr. Albert E. Payne for medical services rendered Mrs. Florence M. Case, in connection with injuries said to have been caused by falling on Peconic Avenue, was presented and ordered placed on file.

Mr. Littlefield of Littlefield, Alger Electric Company presented a proposition to replace some of the traffic signal controls with automatic control and was requested to appear before the Board at the first meeting of the Board in November.

Mr. P.H. Mauer of the Mauer Motor Sales Corporation was present and advised that the oil truck as desired by Town Superintendent Charles O. Downs, would cost \$5995.00

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On motion duly made, seconded it was Resolved That the Town purchase from the Mauer Motor Sales Corporation, Garden City Park, N.Y., one Model T-60-c, 184 1/2 inch wheelbase General Motors Truck with 36 x 8 HD Single Pneumatic Tires Front and 36 x 8 HD Dual Pneumatic Tires rear, to be equipped with Be Luxe type enclosed Cab and 1000 gallon Goodroads Machinery Company's Tank with heating arrangement and Spreader at a price not exceeding \$5995.00, said truck to be paid for in January 1931.

Supervisor Homan thereupon declared the resolution duly carried.

Sup't. of Highways Charles O. Downs, reported having received a letter from Attorney N. O. Petty advising that road to be dedicated to the Town of Riverhead by the Catholic Diocese of Brooklyn, N.Y. at Wading River, had been placed in condition and requested that an inspection of said highway be made.

Supervisor Homan appointed Justice Miller to serve on a committee with Town Sup't. of Highways Charles O. Downs and inspect the road at Wading River and report to the Town Board the result of their findings.

Justice Miller reported having attended the Town Board meeting of Brookhaven Town in connection with the Forge Dam matter and advised that said Board had authorized a survey of said dam and highway leading thereover and would request that plans and specifications be prepared as soon as the matter was approved by County Engineer A.O. Smith.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the days for instruction on the Voting Machines in the Election Districts be and they hereby are designated as October 30, October 31, and November 1, 1930 from the hour of 3 P.M. to 9 P.M. and that the compensation of the instructors be and the same is hereby fixed at \$6.00 per day.
