

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on November 12, 1930 at 2 P.M.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board held October 29th and October 31, 1930 were read and on motion and vote adopted.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the Town Clerk of the Town of Riverhead, be and he hereby is allowed the sum of \$200.00 for services rendered in connection with Election under Section No. 49 of the Election Law.

On motion made by Justice Burnside, seconded By Justice Conklin it was Resolved That Everett M. Fredericks be and he hereby is appointed Justice of the Peace of the Town of Riverhead to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of John Fafinski in the Office of Justice of the Peace.

The Supervisor thereupon declared the resolution duly carried.

On motion by Justice Conklin, seconded by Justice Burnside and duly carried it was Resolved That the Board recommend to the Superintendent of Highways that the highways be cleaned from 10 P.M. to 6 A.M. and that the Town dump truck be used in connection with this work.

Supervisor Homan advised that the bulkhead on the easterly side of the slip at the Town Dock has fallen in and the Town Clerk was requested to write Fred M. Lewis and request that his attention be given this matter.

There being no further business, on motion and vote, the meeting adjourned to meet on November 26, 1930 at 2 P.M.
