

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, Wednesday, January 30, 1929 at 2 P. M.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board held January 9, 1929 were read and on motion and vote approved.

A petition was presented by Edwin M. Lockwood, Attorney for Robert Cunningham, requesting that the Town Board take steps to concrete Old Country Road for a distance of about three miles, commencing at the Polish Church on the east and extending from thence in a westerly direction along the Old Country Road until it intersects the Main Highway from Riverhead to Port Jefferson.

Robert Cunningham was present and addressed the Board relative to the petition presented.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the petition for the concreting of Old Country Road be and the same hereby is referred to the Superintendent of Highways for investigation, and report at the next Town Board meeting.

Mr. Van Brunt Tandy addressed the Board and requested that better street lighting facilities be granted on West Main Street and Marcy Avenue. This matter was referred to the Lighting Committee for investigation.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the Supervisor and the Town Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to borrow upon certificate of indebtedness the sum of Twenty Five Hundred (\$ 2500.00) Dollars, to pay on account of audited bills of January 29, 1929

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized to pay bill in amount of \$833.25 for automobile for the Superintendent of Highways.

WHEREAS, the certificate of indebtedness in the amount of \$2611.70 due January 10, 1929 at the Suffolk County Trust Company, could not be paid, this item ^{not} having been included in the budget, NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED That the Supervisor and the Town Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to issue a new certificate of indebtedness to

the Suffolk County Trust Company in the amount of \$2611.70 dated January 10, 1929, to replace the certificate of indebtedness due on said date.

The opinion of Edwin M. Lockwood, Attorney, regarding the status of the Howell M. Reeve Park and the road leading to it, known as Park Road, was read and ordered placed on file.

A check in the amount of \$20.00 was paid to the Supervisor and Bond presented by Ernest Naber as required by the franchise for the automobile bus line and on motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the Bond of Ernest Naber be and the same hereby is approved as to form, manner of execution and the sufficiency of the sureties.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That William B. Walters, Jr. be and he hereby is appointed Constable of and for the Town of Riverhead, effective February 1, 1929 to fill vacancy of Robert P. Burns, resigned.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
