

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Wednesday, May 15th. 1929 at 2 P. M.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board held on May 1, 1929 were read and on motion and vote approved.

A communication was received from the Automatic Voting Machine Corporation advising that if additional voting machines will be needed for the November Election, that orders should be placed promptly to insure delivery.

Affidavits of Hubert F. Corwin and Ellis S. Duvall certifying to the correctness of the accounting of George E. Luce, Water Commissioner, of receipts and disbursements in the matter of bond sale for Roanoke Heights Enlargement of Water District, were presented and ordered placed on file.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the accounts of George E. Luce as Treasurer of Riverhead Water District showing receipts and disbursements of the proceeds of the bond sale held on the 13th. day of November 1928, for extension of said district known as Roanoke Heights Enlargement dated April 26, 1929, be and the same hereby are approved and he having given a new bond to cover the balance of \$6294.03 remaining in his hands with Joshua T. Fanning and George H. Perkins as sureties dated April 18, 1929, it is further

Resolved, that said new bond be and the same is hereby approved

And it is further Resolved, that the bond of \$36,500. heretofore given by said George E. Luce with Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland as surety be cancelled and this Board hereby consents to the cancellation of same and releases said surety company from all liability thereunder.

A delegation representing the Civic Association of Riverhead was present and requested that steps be taken to relieve the congested condition of sidewalks within the business section of the Town on Saturday nights, caused by the loitering of persons in said section. It was decided

to appoint additional special constables for Saturday and Sunday nights to relieve this condition.

The lighting committee recommended that the petition for an additional street light within the South Jamesport Lighting District at the end of Fourth Street be granted.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the petition for an additional street light within the South Jamesport Lighting District at the end of Fourth Street be granted and that the Town Clerk be directed to request the Long Island Lighting Company to install one 80 C. P. light at this point.

Bond numbered 8204-A, of the National Surety Company bonding Dennis G. Homan, as Supervisor in the amount of \$111,087.67 as required by the State Highway Commission was presented and approved as to its form, manner of execution and sufficiency of the sureties.

On motion and vote, the meeting adjourned.
