

Minutes of a Special Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, Monday, June 17, 1929 at 2 P. M. pursuant to notice.

The following notice of Special meeting was read and the Town Clerk advised that each member of the Town Board had been sent such a notice on the 13th. day of June, 1929

Dear Sir:-

Supervisor Homan has called a Special Meeting of the Town Board for Monday, June 17, 1929 at 2 P. M. for the purpose of considering the matter of a town Dump and such other business as may come before the Board.

Supervisor Homan being absent, on motion duly made, seconded and carried Justice Conklin was appointed Chairman of the meeting.

Justice Penny, reporting as a member of the Committee designated to locate a suitable dumping ground, advised that the Committee had looked over land of Raymond H. Nugent, at Riverhead, land of Leroy Wells, at Aquebogue and land of Felix Rutkoski at Laurel and considered each of the sites suitable.

Mr. Nugent being present advised the Board that he would sell to the Town about seven acres of land on Youngs Avenue, about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles north of the Village, for \$800.00 but would not care to rent the land to the Town.

Mr. Wells advised that he would not sell the land to the Town but would rent same to the Town for a Town Dump at \$1.00 per day.

Mr. Rutkowski advised the Board that he not believe he would care to either rent or sell the swamp land that the Committee had looked at for a Town Dump.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the Board obtain a legal opinion as to the right of the Town Board to purchase land for a Town Dump, the amount that

may be spent for same, powers of the Town Board to create and maintain a Town Dump.

There being no further business, on motion and vote, the meeting adjourned.
