On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the following propositions be submitted to the legal voters of this town at the next bi-ennial town election to be held November 8, 1927.

PROPOSITION NO. 1.

Shall there be inserted in the tax levy for the years 1928 and 1929, the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) for the Board of Health Fund.

PROPOSITION NO. 2.

Shall there be inserted in the tax levy for the years 1928 and 1929, the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) for the Overseer of the Poor Fund.

PROPOSITION NO. 3.

Shall there be inserted in the tax levy for the years 1928 and 1929, the sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) for the purpose of contributing said amount to St. Peter's Hospital of Brroklym, N. Y. , in consideration of treatment of such poor patients that may be sent to such institution from the Town of Riverhead.

On motion and vote, the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, October 26, 1927 at 2 P. M.
