

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office on July 27, 1927 at 2 P.M.

Town Superintendent of Highways Charles O. Downs was present.

The minutes of the meeting of July 11, 1927 were read and on motion adopted.

A communication received from the L.I. Lighting Company advising that it would be necessary to have the traffic signals operated on a meter basis instead of a flat rate basis was read and referred to the Lighting Committee.

A communication received from John Bagshaw was read, requesting that the Board allow him to discount the \$1000.00 which has been allowed his wife, Mary K. Bagshaw, for the land which is now used as a Highway on the road leading from Fishel Avenue to Union Avenue.

On motion and vote it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to obtain a legal opinion as to whether the Board may at this time pay the assessed damages as awarded by the Commissioners to Mary K. Bagshaw for the land now used as a Highway leading from Fishel Avenue to Union Avenue.

A Petition was read by the Town Clerk, signed by taxpayers and merchants on Peconic Avenue, requesting that if new street lights and standards be installed in the business section of Riverhead, that same be also installed on Peconic Avenue.

On motion and vote it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized and directed to pay to the Riverhead Post, American Legion sum of \$200.00 for Post Rent and the sum of \$50.00 for Memorial Day purposes as voted by the people at the last Election.

Charles O. Downs advised the Board that Mr. Danilson would like to present the Town of Riverhead the short strip of land between Ostrander Avenue Extension and Grand Street so as to continue Ostrander Avenue Extension to meet Grand

Street. Charles O. Downs recommended that the Town accept this piece of land for a highway.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the Town through the Supt. of Highways accept by written dedication the land from Ostrander Avenue Extension to Grand Street, and that said land be used as a Highway.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the Supervisor and the Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow upon promissory note the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) and that the Supervisor be authorized and directed to deposit the said sum of Six Hundred Dollars to the Lighting Account for the purpose of paying bills of the South Jamesport Lighting District and that the sum of Six Hundred Dollars be placed in the Budget for the year 1927.

On motion and vote the Meeting adjourned to meet on August 8, 1927 at 2 P. M.
