

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the
Town of Riverhead,, held Saturday, February 19th.1927 at
2P.M.

Supt. of Highways Charles O. Downs was present.

The Minutes of the Meeting of February 8th.1927
were read and approved.

A letter from R.G.Cunningham was read requesting
the Town Board to establish a new road from the State Road
west of the Calverton Bridge to the Polish Church.

A letter addressed to Supervisor Howell from the
Bay Shore Rotary Club containing a copy of Resolution of
Bay Shore Rotary Club, requesting the Board of Supervisors
and the Town Board to help establish a County Health Unit
under the executive management of a full-time health expert
was read by the Town Clerk.

On motion and vote the Town Clerk was directed to
refer the letter of Bay Shore Rotary Club to Health Officer
Alan G. Terrell with a request that he report back to the
Town Board.

The matter of increased compensation for the Tax
Receiver was held over for some future meeting of the Board.

Chas. O. Downs, Supt. of Highways, advised the
Board that the L.I.Lighting Company had requested him to
assist them in making it possible to place the poles of the
L.I.Lighting Company on the north side of Reeves Avenue
near the land of A. H. Reeve.

The Board advised that this matter was entirely
between the L.I.Lighting Company and Mr. Reeve.

Chas. O. Downs, Supt. of Highways advised the
Board that the Good Roads Machinery Company will take the
Snow Plow back and send a new plow which they believe will
prove more satisfactory.

Chas. O. Downs, Supt. of Highways, advised the
Board that his intentions were to get loam from the Town
Highway running through the lands of Koskoski and Robinson
ar Sound Avenue. The Board advised that as this is a Highway
of the Town he has the right to get loam from it.

Justice Raymond H. Vail explained the offer which he had made through the Lions Club to donate building sites and provide housing facilities in order to bring a factory or factories to or near Riverhead.

On motion and vote it was Resolved that the Town Board of Riverhead do all that is possible to assist in bringing a factory ~~or~~ factories to this section of the Island.

On motion and vote Meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, March 2, 1927 at 2 P.M.
