

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the
Town of Riverhead held in the Town Office Wednesday March
3, 1927 at 2 P.M.

Town Supt. of Highways, Chas. O. Downs was present.

The minutes of the Meeting of February 19th.
were read and on motion approved.

A communication from Joseph J. Kreiger of
Riverhead in reference to placing a traffic signal at the
abuttment of Osborn Avenue with Main Street was read and
referred to the Light Committee.

A copy of a Resolution of the Brentwood Community
Association in regard to the establishment of a County
Health Unit under the direction of a full time health
expert health officer was read and on motion placed on
file.

A Petition for an additional suspended street
light on Griffing Avenue in front of the residence of James
S. Elton was read and ordered placed on file.

A delagation from Wading River was present in
regard to the condition of the roads at Wading River. The
Board was addressed by Elihu Miller, William S. Miller,
Joseph Major and James Guy in regard to this condition.

Chas. O. Downs, Supt. of Highways advised ~~the~~
that he had obtained the services of a man to work this
section of the Town Highways and would do all possible to
remedy this condition at Wading River.

Dr. Alan G. Terrell, Town Health Officer address-
ed the Board in regard to the County Health Unit Plan
as requested by the Town Board.

On motion and vote the matter of a County
Health Unit was laid on the table for future reference .

Counselor B. H. Lord addressed the Board in
regard to the salary of the Local Historian.

On motion and vote the Salary of the local
Historian was fixed at \$250.00 per year.

On motion and vote the Supervisor was authorized
to obtain a legal opinion as to the authority of the present
Town Board to authorize the payment of the local Historian
for the calender year 1925.

Mr. Harry Jones of South Jamesport addressed the Board relative to the washout at South Jamesport during the recent storm.

On motion and vote Chas. O. Downs was instructed to look into the condition at South Jamesport and ascertain the proper method of correcting same.

Park V. Arnold, Manager of the Riverhead Office of the L.I. Lighting Company, addressed the Board and presented a Gas Franchise with a request that the Town Board consent to this Franchise.

On motion and vote the matter of a Gas Franchise for the L.I. Lighting Company was held over to the next meeting of the Town Board and the Supervisor was authorized to obtain the services of Counsel to look into this matter and see that the interests of the Town would be properly protected under the franchise.

On motion and vote the Resolution of the Town Board of December 30th. 1925 raising the salary of the Assessors from \$700.00 per year to \$850.00 per year was amended to read as Follows" Resolved that the salary of the Assessors be and the same is hereby raised from \$700.00 per year to \$850.00 per year and actual and necessary expenses while in the performance of their duties".

WHEREAS the Community has sustained a severe loss through the removal of Orvis H. Luce and Whereas he was one of the Town Officials of Riverhead Town,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that this Meeting express its keen sense of the great loss the Town and the whole Community has suffered and also its appreciation of the valuable services the late Mr. Luce rendered the Town Board both in his official capacity as a member of the Board of Audit and also as a fellow townsman and also of his unfailing courtesy and broadminded view of public affairs and,
