

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office on Wednesday, March 30th., 1927 at 2 P.M.

Supt. of Highways Charles O. Downs was present.

The minutes of the Meeting of March 10, were read and on motion approved.

The following communications were read and ordered placed on file:

Communication from Hattie L. Huber regarding the damage done to the bulkhead at the foot of Green and Front Streets, South Jamesport during the recent storm.

Communication from Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, advising Supervisor Howell that the matter of Signs for Municipalities and Streams had been dropped.

Communication from Frank J. Stoltz, of the L.I. Lighting Company advising the Supervisor that he was leaving for a trip through the southern States he would be unable to meet with the Town Board as requested but would do so at a later date if requested by the Town Board.

Mr. Howard Downs and Mr. Edward Downs of South Jamesport and Mr. Huber representing the Huber Estates were present and addressed the Board relative to the condition that the recent storm left the bulkhead at South Jamesport and requesting the Board to rebuild the bulkhead in front of the Road known as Front Street.

On motion and vote, the Supt. of Highways was authorized to secure the necessary materials and work in conjunction with Messrs. Downs and Huber to establish a Bulkhead at South Jamesport at the foot of Front Street.

Mr. Howard Downs requested the Board to put the stonewall in front of the Town Road in front of the Great Peconic Bay House in condition and was advised that Supt. of Highways Charles O. Downs would take care of this.

Robert Cunningham addressed the Board relative to establishing a road at Calverton through land which he states he owns.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor and the Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow upon promissory note, the sum of One Hundred Sixty and 87/100 (\$160.87) Dollars to pay on account of audited bills of March 29, 1927

On motion and vote it was RESOLVED that Forrest G. Downs, Tax Receiver, be allowed to employ a clerk to assist him for five days in balancing the tax roll.

Charles O. Downs, Supt. of Highways presented the "AGREEMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF HIGHWAY MONEYS".

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the Agreement for the Expenditure of Highways Moneys, as submitted by Town Supt. of Highways, Charles O. Downs be approved.

On motion, duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the Town Clerk be authorized to purchase a complete set of McKinney's Consolidated Laws of New York consisting of 73 books at a price of \$159.80 and the Supplemental service for this set, at an annual price of \$20.00

On motion and vote, the Meeting adjourned to meet on Saturday, April 9, 1927 at 1 o'clock.
