

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office on Wednesday, May 25, 1927 at 2 P.M.

Town Supt. of Highways Charles O. Downs was present.

The minutes of the Meeting of May 18, 1927 were read and on motion adopted.

Mr. Brewster of Hocker, Wheeler and Brewster was present and addressed the Board, inquiring as to whether the Road running north from Sound Avenue, between the lands of Gus. Koskoski and Harold Robinson to the land formerly of Cora Reeves Barnes, now owned by Hocker, Wheeler and Brewster was a public highway.

Mr. Brewster was informed by the Board that this road had been defined and a record of same was on file in the Town Office.

The Report of the Lighting Committee was as follows:
The Lighting Committee recommends:

First::

That the plan of the Horni Signal Manufacturing Corporation as will be submitted by their representative be adopted.

Second::

That a new plan of Street Lighting within the business section of Riverhead Village be adopted but this committee does not favor the method of using the poles now in use believing that a more ornamental form of poles should be used and that the lights should be extended on Griffin Avenue from the business section to the L.I. Railroad Tracks but would advise this matter to be held over to the next meeting of the Board.

Third:

That the request of Dr. Leonard Blumgard of Wading River for street lights at Wading River be granted after the necessary petition is filed providing not more than eight additional lights are required.

Fourth:

That in the matter of the extention of Lighting District number 1, in the Village of Riverhead in the River-side ^{Drive} Section, this matter be held over until the Petition of property owners of New Road is submitted when the Lighting District will be defined.

Fifth:

That the signers of Petition of several taxpayers namely Mrs. Lena Davis, Joseph Merry and the Le Sha Corporation for additional street lights at Wading River, should petition the Town Board of the Town of Brookhaven as the Committee believes this section to be in the Township of Brookhaven.

Sixth:

That one additional street light be installed on the north side of Second Street, midway between present light and Roanoke Avenue, said light to be about 150 feet west of Roanoke Avenue.

That one additional light be installed on the south side of First Street, midway between the light at the corner of Roanoke Avenue and First Street and the light now at Cat Alley.

On motion and vote it was Resolved that an additional street light be installed on the north side of Second Street midway between present light and Roanoke Avenue, about 150 feet west of Roanoke Avenue and that an additional street light be installed on the south side of First Street, midway between light at corner of Roanoke Avenue and First Street and light at Cat Alley.

The Representative of the Horni Signal Manufacturing Corporation submitted two plans for the consideration of the Board.

On motion and vote it was Resolved that ^{of a system of} the Horni Signal Manufacturing Corporation install one traffic signal lights on a ten day trial at a cost not to exceed \$1300.00 if said light proves satisfactory we are to enter into a contract with the Horni Signal Manufacturing Corporation if said light does not prove staisfatory the Town to pay the temporary installation charges.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the Town Board request Supervisor Howell to ask the Board of Supervisors to pass a resolution fixing the compensation of the Overseer of the Poor of Riverhead Town at \$5.00 per day and expenses.

The Street Lighting Contract with the L. I. Lighting Company for the South Jamesport Lighting District was submitted and on motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the Town Board enter into a contract with the L. I. Lighting Company.

On motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on June 1, 1927 at 3 P.M.
