

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office on Thursday, November 10th., 1927 at 2 P. M.

Charles O. Downs, Town Superintendent of Highways was present.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board, held October 26, 1927 were read and on motion adopted.

Communications were read from Walter I. Jones, Town Clerk of Brookhaven Town and Joseph N. Hallock, Town Clerk of Southold Town, advising that the Town Boards of these towns would be represented at the Hearing of the Commission to Recodify the Town Law, to be held at Mineola on November 11, 1927.

A communication/received from C. A. Huhne, of Babylon, L. I., Resident Engineer of the State of New York, Department of Public Works, with copy attached of an opinion of the Attorney General in regard to erection of Stop and Go signals upon or over a State or County Highway without a Permit from the State Superintendent of Public Works.

A communication was read from H. J. Goodwin, Sales Manager of the Horni Signal Manufacturing Corporation submitting a proposal for the installation of Traffic Signals at the corner of Roanoke Avenue and Main Street similar to those installed at the corner of Main Street and Griffin Avenue, the total cost of material and workmanship for the Roanoke Avenue and Main Street and Griffin Avenue and Main Street Traffic Signal Lights to be \$1357.50

On motion and vote the Town Clerk for directed to obtain a permit from the State Superintendent of Public Works for the installation of traffic signals at the abutment of Roanoke Avenue and Main Street and upon receipt of same to place an order with the Horni Signal Manufacturing Corporation for the installation of traffic signals at the abutment of Roanoke Avenue and Main Street, the cost of material and installation for this traffic light together with those now in use at the abutment of Griffing Avenue and Main Street to be \$1357.50

On motion made by Justice Penny, seconded by Justice Burnside and carried it was Resolved that Justice Raymond H. Vail be sent to the Public Hearing of the Commission to Recodify that Town Law at Mineola to represent the Town of Riverhead at the Public Hearing of the Commission.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the compensation of the Town Clerk be and the same is hereby fixed at \$200.00 for the Year 1927 for services pertaining to election as per Chapter 49 of the Election Law.

Almon G. Rasquin, representing the American Legion, addressed the Board, requesting that one parking space directly to the west and one space directly to the east of the driveway leading into the American Legion Parking Place, on Main Street, be discontinued, thereby leaving room for automobiles to enter and leave said parking place without danger to the public.

Justices Corwin and Vail were appointed a committee to look into the matter of parking near the entrance to the American Legion Parking Place.

The estimate for Highway Purposes for the year 1928, of Charles O. Downs, Town Superintendent of Highways was submitted and on motion and vote said estimate was received and held over to the next meeting of the Town Board, so that the public might have an opportunity to express their opinion on same.

Charles O. Downs, Town Supt. of Highways, made a request that the sum of \$2000.00 be transferred from the Machinery Fund to Item No. 1, of the Highway Fund, General Repairs.

On motion and vote, it was Resolved that the Supervisor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to transfer the sum of \$2000.00 from the Machinery Fund to the Highway Fund, Item No. 1.

On motion and vote the next meeting of the Town Board, was called to be held in the Town Office, on Saturday, November 19th. 1927 at 10 A. M.
