The minutes of the meeting of February 16th, were read and approved.

The committee on tractor, snow plow and road breaker reported that they had conferred with Supt. of Highways Fleet of Southold Town, and Supt. of Highways Murray of Brookhaven Town and that they were advised that a 10 Ton Tractor was the most practical tractor to purchase. The Committee recommended that the Town obtain a 10 Ton tractor. No action was taken and the Committee was instructed to report at next meeting as to make of tractor and mode of paying for same. The committee on Traffic Light at the intersection of Griffing Avenue and Main Street reported that they agreed that some lighting device was necessary at this point.

Mr. Nagle addressed the Board and exhibited a Traffic Signal.

On motion duly made seconded and carried Mr. Nagle was requested to submit a bid in the form of a contract, for a Electric Traffic Signal to be placed at the intersection of Griffing Avenue and Main Street, the price to include the cost of installing, said light to be operated from the sidewalk.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was Resolved that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow the Sum of \$2456.45 to pay on account of audited bills of February 23, 1936.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the Supervisor was authorized to pay the bill of Perkins & Co., in the amount of \$49.00.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned to meet at the Town Clerk's Office on Monday, March 8, 1936 at 2 P.M.
