

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held at the Wading River School House, on June 12th. 1926 at 2 P.M.

The Town Board of the Town of Riverhead met with the Town Board of the Town of Brookhaven at the Wading River School House for the purpose of holding a public hearing on the establishment of a Lighting District at Wading River.

The Petition to establish a Lighting District at Wading River, signed by a majority of the property holders in the proposed district, was read by Town Clerk Burns.

Robert S. Guy addressed the Boards and stated that he had signed the Petition for the purpose of securing house lights and that he was not especially interested in street lights.

The Boards were addressed by Mr. Nesmith, Mr. Bittner Mr. Arnold, William L. Miller and Father Regulski.

The opinion of the Boards was that the establishment of a Lighting District at Wading River would tend to bring about the matter of house lighting.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the Town Board of Brookhaven Town and the Town Board of Riverhead Town do hereby establish a Lighting District at Wading River in the Townships of Brookhaven and Riverhead described as follows:

"Beginning at the mouth of Wading River Creek on Long Island Sound and running thence easterly along the shore of Long Island Sound to Hulse's Landing Road; thence southerly and easterly along Hulse's Landing Road to the Port Jefferson Riverhead State Highway; thence westerly along the said State Highway to the Town Line between the towns of Riverhead and Brookhaven; thence still westerly along the State Highway to the Randall Road; thence northerly along the Randall Road to the North Country Road; thence northerly along the westerly line of the land of Lucy Howell adjoining the land of Balford and Terrill, to the Mill Pond; thence northwesterly across the Mill Pond to the head of Mill Creek and the line dividing the Towns of Riverhead and Brookhaven; thence northerly along Mill Creek to the Wading River Creek; thence westerly and northerly along Wading River Creek to the Long Island Sound and the point or place of beginning."

The Town Board of Brookhaven all voted Yes on the foregoing resolution.

The vote on the foregoing resolution by the Town Board of Riverhead was as follows:-
