

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office on August 9th. 1926 at 2 P.M.

Town Superintendent of Highways Charles O. Downs and County Superintendent of Highways A. O. Smith were present.

The minutes of the meeting of July 28th. were read and on motion approved.

A letter from the State Department of Education was brought to the attention of the Board, advising that the Town Board should appoint an Attendance Officer for the school Year of 1926-27 and fix the Compensation for same

On motion and vote, it was Resolved that Lorimer M. Raynor be appointed Attendance Officer for the school year 1926-27 and that the compensation of the Attendance Officer be fixed at \$4.00 per day with an expense of \$.15 per mile allowed.

The Town Clerk was directed to notify Lorimer M. Raynor of his appointment and also notify P.B. Matthews, District Superintendent.

Justice Burnside reporting on the committee regarding placing the Overseer of the Poor on a salary basis, stated that in his opinion it was first necessary for the Town to be on a budget system.

Supervisor Howell appointed Justices Vail, Corwin, Burnside and Penny a committee to look into the matter of placing the Town of Riverhead on a budget system.

Superintendent of Highways Charles O. Downs requested the sum of \$5000.00 to be placed in the Bridge Fund to be used to repair the Bridge at Aquebogue.

On motion and vote the Supervisor and Town Clerk were authorized and directed to borrow upon Certificates of Indebtedness the sum of \$5000.00 to be placed in the Bridge Fund for Extraordinary Repairs ~~xxxxxxx~~ for repairing the bridge at Aquebogue, N.Y.

Superintendent of Highways Charles O. Downs advised the Board that the Contractor who is to build the road at Jamesport desired to purchase sand from the Town this sand to be taken from the Town Pit, at a price of \$.30 per yard.

On motion and vote the Superintendent of Highways was authorized to sell sand to the Contractor building the road at Jamesport at a price of \$.30 if he has the legal right to do so.

Supervisor Howell appointed a committee consisting of Justices Corwin, Vail, Burnside and Penny, to examine the Parking Regulations of the Town of Riverhead and to make corrections if necessary and to present said Parking Regulations to the Town Board for their approval.

On motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet at the call of the Chair.
