

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office on September 2, 1926 at 2 P.M.

Supt. of Highways Charles O. Downs was present.

The minutes of the meeting of August 19th. were read and on motion adopted.

Charles O. Downs, Superintendent of Highways, brought a letter to the attention of the Board, from Hollis V. Warner in which Mr. Warner requested permission to run a narrow gauge track over the Town Highway from one section of his duck farm to another.

On motion and vote, the Superintendent of Highways was authorized to get a legal opinion as to the right of the Town Board or the Superintendent of Highways to grant permission to run a railroad over the Town Highways.

A legal opinion was read by the Town Clerk concerning the right of the Town Board after having advertised for bids to reduce the number of feet on concrete to be laid without re-advertising.

On motion and vote it was : Resolved that the Supervisor and the Town Clerk, or either of them, be , and they hereby are, authorized, empowered and directed to enter into a contract with the Automatic Registering Machine Co. Inc., for the purchase of one (1) U.S. Standard Voting Machine of the 9 row.30 column size at the net price of \$940.00 each, F.O.B. Cars, Jamestown, N.Y. and be it further ,

Resolved, that in payment for said Voting Machine, the Supervisor is hereby authorized, empowered and directed upon receipt of said machine and upon audit of bill for same to pay to the Automatic Registering Machine Co. Inc., the sum of \$940.00

Charles O. Downs, Supt. of Highways, addressed the Board about the Town Property at Aquebogue in the Ravatone Realty Development. Mr. Cockran representing the Ravatone Realty Corporation, advised the Board that they were desirous of determining the exact location of the Town Property at the Ravatone Realty Development at Aquebogue

Supervisor Howell appointed Justices Corwin and Vail to act on a Committee with the Supt. of Highways and determine the location of the Town Property at the Ravatone Realty Corporation Development at Aquebogue.

William L. Miller addressed the Board about the Meeting of the taxpayers of the Wading River Lighting District and stated that at this meeting of the taxpayers, the taxpayers voted unanimously in favor of the Town Board contracting with the L.I. Lighting Company for the installation of 44 lights at a yearly rental of \$50.00 per light for a period of five years.

On motion and vote the Supervisor was authorized and directed to sign a contract with the L.I. LIGHTING COMPANY for the installation of 44 street lights at Wading River, at a yearly rental of \$50.00 per light for a period of five years

On motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on September 16, 1926 at 2 P.M.
