
Health Officer Alan G.Terrell was present.

The Supervisor read a notice of hearing directing him to appear before the Health Commissioner at the Riverhead Country Club on March 20th, 1925 at 11-30 A.M. and show cause why the sewer discharge into Peconic River by the Town of Riverhead should not be discontinued and an action brought against the town to recover penalties for an alleged violation of the Public Health Law.
