

Minutes of February 25th, read and on motion adopted. Justice Burnside of the Committee on the proposed Legislation to permit the transfer of the Town Park funds and the audit and payment of the claim of the Long Island Railroad Company for reimbursement for the cost of grading at Sweezy Bridge in excess of 3000 Cu. yards incurred pursuant to resolutions of the Town Board dated May 27th, 1921, reported that the desired information had been obtained and was in the hands of Justice Corwin of the committee ready for the preparation of proper bills for introduction in the Legislature.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that Assemblyman Downs of this district be requested to introduce a bill authorizing the transfer of the town park funds to such other funds as the town board may determine.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved, that Assemblyman Downs of this district be requested to introduce a bill authorizing the town board of Auditors to audit the aforesaid claim of the Long Island Railroad Company, and authorizing the Supervisor to pay such claim as audited, in an amount not exceeding \$ 2011.45, out of any funds available, and in the absence of available funds, authorizing the Town Board to borrow a sufficient sum in anticipation of taxes.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the meeting adjourned to meet at the Town Clerk's office on March 20 th. at 11-30 A.M.
