

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Clerk's office Wednesday April 1st, 1925 at 2-00 P.M.

Minutes of the meeting of March 20th, 1925 were read and on motion adopted.

On motion duly made seconded and carried Justices Dwight T. Corwin and Raymond H. Vail were appointed as a committee to recommend the type of traffic signal and situation there for.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was recommended that the Superintendent of Highways acquire the triangular piece of property belonging to Nathaniel A. Talmage at the intersection of Osborne Avenue and North Road for the sum of \$ 150.00 for the purpose of altering Osborne Avenue.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the agreement made by the Superintendent of Highways with Daniel R. Young for damages in keeping open the existing water drain during the year 1924 be approved.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized to borrow the sum of \$ 4300.00 to pay audited bills of March 31st, 1925.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be, and they hereby are authorized to borrow the sum of \$ 125.00 in anticipation of taxes against the Riverhead Water District, and to place the same to the credit of said Water District Fund, for the purpose of paying the balance due for compensation of the Water Commissioners.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the meeting adjourned to meet at the Town Clerk's office on Tuesday April 14th, 1925 at 2-00 P.M.
