

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Clerk's office April 14th, 1925 at 2-00 P.M.

Minutes of the meeting of April 1st. read and on motion adopted.

The Supervisor stated that he had received a check in the amount of the final refund on the contract for the construction for the westerly part of the Riverhead-Port Jefferson Highway No.8111.

On motion duly made seconded unmarried Justice Raymond H.Vail and Town Clerk Frank Sollar were appointed a committee to confer with the Suffolk County Trust Co. and negotiate for the redemption of bonds of the issue of 1922 sold for the construction of the aforesaid highway, in an amount for which funds might now be available.

The Town Clerk read the following letter received from Mrs.Cora B.Reeve Barnes:-

Riverhead, N.Y. April 13,
1925.

The Town Board of Riverhead, N.Y.

Gentlemen:-

In reference to the property on Long Island Sound, West of Roanoke Avenue, which I deeded to the Town of Riverhead to be opened and used as a Public Park and which was so accepted by your board in 1923.

As the deed of gift has not been complied with and as I understand your board has decided that the property is not suitable for the purpose for which it was deeded, I now request that the said property be deeded back to me forthwith.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the communication was laid on the table.

The Superintendent of Highways Charles O. Downs requested the board to accompany him on an inspection tour of the town highways to commence at 9-00 o'clock on the 18th day of April 1925.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was decided that such inspection be made.

A petition requesting the paving of Main Street between the present concrete road bed and the curb on each side of Main Street between Peconic Avenue and the west side of Griffing Avenue, was filed with the Town Clerk.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the same was laid on the table to be taken up at the next meeting and the committee on the change of curb line on Main Street were requested to proceed with their duties.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the report of the committee on traffic signals recommending the installation of an electric traffic signal at the intersection of Main Street and Peconic Avenue was received and approved, and it was resolved, that a signal, as recommended, be purchased.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the meeting adjourned to meet at the Town Clerk's office on Saturday April 18th, 1925 at 9-00 A.M.
