

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Clerk's office Wednesday April 29th, 1925 at 2-00 P.M.

Minutes of meeting of April 18th, 1925 read and on motion adopted.

Mr and Mrs Walter F. Barnes appeared before the Board relative to the matter of his letter of April 13th, 1925 requesting the return of the property dedicated for park purposes.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the Supervisor appointed Justices Robert Burnside and Dwight T. Corwin as a committee to investigate what procedure might be necessary to be taken by the Town Board.

On motion duly made seconded and carried Justices George E. Penny and Raymond H. Vail were appointed as a committee to confer with Health Officer Alan G. Terrell with regard to the health officer proposal for regulation for the care of dogs.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that pursuant to Chapter 292 of the laws of 1925 the Supervisor be and is hereby authorized and directed to transfer the sum of \$ 5000.00 from the Park Fund to the Highway Fund for Special improvements.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the sum of \$ 5000.00 this day directed to be transferred from the Park Fund to the Highway Fund for Special Improvements be expended for the construction of a concrete roadbed eighteen feet wide and six inches thick on Jamesport Lane commencing at the Main Road and running south therefrom.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow the sum of \$ 2400.00 to pay audited bills of April 28th, 1925.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Supervisor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to contract with the Long Island Lighting Co, for the connection and service of electric current to the electric flash signal to be installed at the intersection of Main Street and Peconic Avenue at the usual rate and fixed rate for such service.
