Minutes of the meeting of May 14th read and on motion adopted.

The Town Clerk read a communication from E.E.Smith relative to the dumping of rubbish on the Boulevard at Jamesport.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that a sign be placed at this point signed by the Board of Health prohibiting the dumping of rubbish on said property.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that all the committees be discharged except the electric light committee.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow the sum of \$ 4500.00 to pay audited bills of May 26th, 1925.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Supervisor appoint the necessary number of officers to handle the traffic on Memorial Day.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Superintendent of Highways Charles O. Downs and Motorcycle Officer Andrew H. Prudent mark the stalls for automobiles on Main Street, in accordance with the Parking Regulation adopted by this Board on April 14th, 1924. Said Stalls to be eight feet wide from center to center and the line to be four inches wide.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the board adjourned to meet at the Town Clerk's office Monday June 15th, 1925 at 2-00 P.M.
