Minutes of the meeting of May 27th, 1925 read and on motion adopted.

Health Officer Alan G. Terrell informed the board that he had received complaints regarding the unhealthy conditions of the duck farm of Vincent Adams.


On motion duly made seconded and carried the Health Officer was directed to further investigate the condition on such farm and arrange for a meeting of the Board of Health at which said Vincent Adams should be directed to appear.

On motion duly made seconded and carried Sup't of Highways Charles O. Downs and Justice George E. Penny were appointed a committee with power to employ Counsel to investigate and prepare plans of procedure for the widening of the present roadbed on Jamesport Lane, at, and the removal of the abutment of the Long Island Railroad bridge crossing said highway.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that an additional voting machine be rented for the next general election in each of the fifth, sixth and seventh election districts and the Town Clerk was directed to communicate with the Automatic Registering Machine Company inquiring as to the cost of the same.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow upon promissory note due December 15th, 1925 the sum of Twelve hundred and thirty five and 00/100 dollars, in anticipation of taxes, for the purpose of paying interest due June 1, 1925, on bonds of the Riverhead Water District.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the board adjourned to meet at the Town Clerk's office on July 1st, 1925 at 2-00 P.M.
