Minutes of the meeting of June 15th, 1925 read and on motion adopted.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the Supervisor was authorized and directed to pay to the Conservation Commission the sum of \$ 108.36 for fire rebate due from the Town for 1924.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow the sum of \$ 2500.00 to pay audited bills of June 30th, 1925.

On motion duly made seconded and carried Justices Robert Burnside and Dwight T. Corwin were appointed a committee to confer with the Sup't of Highways and Special Constable Prudent and to prepare a draft of suitable proposed amendments to the parking regulations adopted April 15th, 1924 and to present the same at the next meeting of the Town Board for consideration.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Town Board hereby endorses the preparation of and plans for, the National Defense Test on July 4th, 1925, and urges the residence of Riverhead and vicinity to co-operate with the committee in charge of same and to join in the ceremonies to be held on said day.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved

Whereas, the Town of Riverhead will conduct a celebration in accordance with the request of the President of the United States and the proclamation of the Governor of the State of New York, on July 4, 1925 and,


Whereas, this Board has been officially requested to supervise such celebration, and,

Whereas, it is necessary to incur certain expenses in the proper conduct of said celebration, and no provision of law exists which will permit of defraying said expenses

as a town charge,

Now Therefore, be it resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead hereby requests and urges the citizens of said town to contribute to said expenses, and for the purpose of collecting contributions therefor, motorcycle officer Andrew H. Prudent is hereby designated for the purpose of soliciting and receiving such contributions.
