

Minutes of a special meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, held at the Town Clerk's office in said town on the 17th day of July, 1925, at 2 P.M.

The Town Clerk announced that the meeting was called for the purpose of hearing an application by the Superintendent of Highways for approval to repair certain highways under Section 93 of the Highway Law.

The Superintendent of Highways presented a request dated this day certifying that the highways known as River Road, Middle Island Road, Osborne Avenue, Main North Road and the Northville Pike were damaged during the months of June and July for their entire length, and requesting approval to repair the same.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was resolved that the request be granted and the repairing of said highways be approved. The members of the Board their upon signed the approval to said request.

The Superintendent of Highways stated that the cost of said repairs would be the sum of \$6000.00.

The Town Clerk thereupon certified to the said request and approval that the probable cost of such repairs would be the sum of \$6000.00.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to borrow upon the credit of the Town, and issue certificates of indebtedness therefor, to the amount of \$6000.00 to be paid out by the Supervisor in the repair of the highways mentioned in the request of the Superintendent of Highways this day made and filed.

The Superintendent of Highways requested that the sum of \$500.00 be transferred from the Bridge Fund to the Machinery Fund.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, the Supervisor was directed to transfer the sum of \$500.00 from the Bridge Fund to the Machinery Fund.
