

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, held at the Town Clerk's office on Saturday, October 10, 1925, at 2 P.M.

The minutes of the meeting of September 30, 1925, were read, and upon motion adopted.

On Motion duly made, seconded and carried, it was resolved that the Town Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to purchase a cabinet safe through Mr. Chas. Elton for the sum of \$220.00

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was resolved that the following propositions be submitted to the legal voters of this town at the next bi-ennial town election to be held November 3, 1925:-

PROPOSITION NO. 1.

Shall there be inserted in the tax levy for the years 1926 and 1927, the sum of One thousand dollars (\$1000.00) for the Board of Health Fund.

PROPOSITION NO. 2.

Shall there be inserted in the tax levy for the years 1926 and 1927, the sum of Fifteen hundred dollars (\$1500.00) for the Overseer of the Poor Fund.

PROPOSITION NO. 3.

Shall there be inserted in the tax levy for the years 1926 and 1927, the sum of One hundred and fifty (\$150.00) for the purpose of contributing said amount to St. Peter's Hospital of Brooklyn, N. Y., in consideration of treatment of such poor patients that may be sent to such institution from the Town of Riverhead.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried the board adjourned to meet at the Town Clerk's office on October 28, 1925 at 2 P.M.
