

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Clerk's office Monday January 21st, 1924 at 2-00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

The Committee appointed to confer with the different bankers in the town relative to the \$ 80,000 dollar bond issue reported at this meeting.

On motion made seconded and carried it was resolved that the bonds to be issued for the construction of the concrete road bed in Edwards and Roanoke Avenues be of the denomination of \$1000.00 Dollars each bearing interest at 4½ % payable semi-annually on July 1st and January 1st. and that the said bonds mature as follows: \$2000.00 Dollars thereof to be payable each year up to and including January 1st. 1934 and \$ 6000.00 Dollars thereof to be payable each year thereafter up to and including January 1st.1944.

On motion made seconded and carried the committee appointed to confer with bankers was continued for the purpose of ascertaining whether registered or coupon bonds would be more beneficial.

On motion made seconded and carried the lease for the town offices for two years was accepted and filed.

On motion made seconded and carried the action of the board taken on January 3rd, 1924 authorizing the Superintendent of Highways to hire a Deputy and fixing the salary therefor at \$ 300.00 per annum was rescinded.

Superintendent of Highways Charles O.Downs addressed the board and recommended that the board appoint John C.Stark as Deputy Superintendent of Highways at a compensation to be fixed by the board.

On motion made seconded and carried it was resolved that John C.Stark be hereby appointed Deputy Superintendent of Highways at the rate of compensation of \$3.00 per day not to exceed one hundred days during any one year.

On motion made seconded and carried Superintendent of Highways was authorized to have his car insured for full

coverage.

It was decided to hold the next meeting of the board on
Wednesday, January 30th, 1924 at 2-00 P.M.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
